To complete the Texas A&M University System Child Protection Training through the External Gateway (for program volunteers-not A&M employees), please follow the directions below.

1 VISIT THE TRAINING PORTAL WEBSITE

- B.** OR Access the website through the CPM Website. Go to CPM.tamu.edu -> Compliance -> Child Protection Training. Select the maroon oval that is labeled "TRAINING – VOLUNTEERS".
